Professional Development

Two complimentary professional development sessions were conducted on the Goondeen Way at Brisbane Catholic Education's Ngutana Lui Educated Centre in Inala (Yuggera Country) following interest from more than 80 teachers from 20 schools. Further sessions are planned.
